First Baptist Family,

After nearly a year and a half, things are finally beginning to return to some semblance of normal. By now, you've already seen or heard the announcement from the CDC recommending that people fully vaccinated no longer need to wear masks or physically distance from others. As I've previously mentioned, the CDC still recommends that those who are not vaccinated, including children, and those with compromised immune systems continue to wear masks. Additionally, I'm sure that some who are fully vaccinated will choose to continue to wear a mask for various reasons. To be respectful of those who choose to wear masks and those who don't, we've planned several church events this summer. These events are primarily going to be outside.

June is arguably going to be our busiest month. Our Youth are going to have mission trip training and a fundraiser event, but we're also going to have some churchwide events as well. On Wednesday, June 9 at 6 PM, we're going to have an Ice Cream Chill Off. We're inviting people to bring their best homemade ice cream, and we'll have a contest to determine the winner. We will still need some adult volunteers, so if you are interested in helping, please see Ben. Our Youth will go on their mission trip June 21 -27. And we'll have two guests on Wednesday nights in June. On Wednesday, June 23, Gennady and Mina Podgaisky, missionaries serving in Kiev, Ukraine, will be joining us via Zoom. If the Podgaiskys sound familiar to you, that's because they spoke at FBC Bristol about 13 or 14 years ago. Then on Wednesday, June 30, Joshua and Jessica Hearne, missionaries serving in Danville, VA, will be joining us via Zoom. Josh and Jessica were scheduled to join us in person in

May 2020, but COVID postponed their visit.

In July things will slow down a little bit. We're going to be taking our annual Wednesday night break during the month of July, but our youth will be going to camp July 20-24, and we'll have a church-wide movie on Friday, July 30. You're invited to bring a blanket or chair, some of your favorite movie snacks, and join us for a family-friendly movie outside. Then in August, we'll have Youth Sunday and a choir cook -out on Sunday, August 8. And on Wednesday, August 11, we'll have our Fall Kick-Off, where we'll kick off our Wednesday evening and fall programming. A little later this year, the church picnic is going to be on Sunday, September 12. We're also going to have some other children and youth events sprinkled in throughout the summer. More information on all of these events will be made available as we get closer to them, so please continue to read your weekly e-news and look for the announcements in our worship bulletin.

After time apart, we're finally turning the corner on this awful pandemic and able to safely resume numerous events. While I know this summer will be busy and that many of you will be traveling and taking some much-needed vacation (and you can count me and the rest of the church staff in that group, too), I hope that you'll join us for as many of these events as you can. Not wearing masks in worship, food and fellowship together, all of that sounds like normal church. They are things I've missed terribly over these last several months, and I know you have, too. So, in the midst of your travels and summer busyness, I encourage you to join us in worship and in fellowship. I know that you'll be glad that you did.

Searching for Happiness: How Generosity, Faith, and Other Spiritual Habits Can Lead to a Full Life by Martin Thielen. Using psychological research, personal anecdotes, and Scripture, Thielen shows that happiness is an "inside" job. He describes ten practices that **DO** contribute to happiness in this easy-to-read book in which he shares many of his own experiences as well as those of others through which he illustrates his lessons. Perfect for small group study, there is an 18page guide for Study and Reflection as well as a page titled "Tips for Group Leaders." Notes with additional resources are included. This study could provide opportunities for individuals in a small group to share their own experiences and learn from each other in addition to the book.
